For Pregnant Women				
<b>TT-1</b>	Early in pregnancy	0.5 ml	Intra-muscular	Upper Arm
<b>TT-2</b>	4 weeks after TT-1*	0.5 ml	Intra-muscular	Upper Arm
<b>TT- Booster</b>	1 dose if TT dose given in last 3 yrs*	0.5 ml	Intra-muscular	Upper Arm
For Infants				
<b>BCG</b>	At birth or as early as possible till one year of age	0.1ml (0.05ml until 1 month age)	Intra-dermal	Left Upper Arm
<b>Hepatitis B-0</b>	At birth or as early as possible within 24 hours	0.5 ml	Intra-muscular	Antero-lateral side of mid-thigh
<b>OPV-0</b>	At birth or as early as possible within the first 15 days	2 drops	Oral	Oral
<b>OPV 1,2 &amp; 3</b>	At 6 weeks, 10 weeks & 14 weeks	2 drops	Oral	Oral
<b>DPT1,2 &amp; 3</b>	At 6 weeks, 10 weeks & 14 weeks	0.5 ml	Intra-muscular	Antero-lateral side of mid thigh
<b>Hepatitis B 1, 2 &amp; 3</b>	At 6 weeks, 10 weeks & 14 weeks	0.5 ml	Intra-muscular	Antero-lateral side of mid-thigh
<b>Measles 1</b>	9 completed months-12 months.	0.5 ml	Sub-cutaneous	Right upper Arm
<b>Vitamin A (1stdose)</b>	At 9 months with measles	1 ml	Oral	Oral
For Children				
<b>DPT booster-1</b>	16-24 months	0.5 ml	Intra-muscular	Antero-lateral side of mid-thigh
<b>OPV Booster</b>	16-24 months	2 drops	Oral	Oral
<b>Measles 2</b>	16-24 months	0.5 ml	Sub-cutaneous	Right upper Arm
<b>Japanese Encephalitis**</b>	16-24 months with DPT/OPV booster	0.5 ml	Sub-cutaneous	Left Upper Arm
<b>Vitamin A (2<sup>nd</sup> dose)</b>	with DPT/OPV booster	2 ml	Oral	Oral
<b>Vitamin A (3<sup>rd</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> dose)</b>	One dose every 6 months up to the age of 5 years.	2 ml	Oral	Oral
<b>DPT Booster-2</b>	5-6 years	0.5 ml.	Intra-muscular	Upper Arm
<b>TT</b>	10 years & 16 years	0.5 ml	Intra-muscular	Upper Arm

\*Give TT-2 or Booster doses preferably before 36 weeks of pregnancy.

\*\* JE Vaccine, in select endemic districts

Note- In selected states, pentavalent vaccine 1, 2 & 3 dose replaces DPT 1, 2 & 3 dose and Hepatitis B 1, 2 & 3 doses.
